As always, we offer a safe, supervised and fun learning environment for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade students from 3:15 to 5:00, Tuesday through Friday. We provide a healthy snack right after school, and then break into smaller groups for an activity that runs from 3:30 to 4:30. You may pick up your child between 4:30 and 5:00 at the front of the school. In addition, we are now offering a very limited program on Mondays at the Grand County Library from 1:00 to 3:00. - ❖ Registration forms are **due by Wednesday, September 9th**. This is your **only opportunity** to enroll in Session One.
- ❖ Session One will **begin Monday, September 14th** and will end with the first trimester on November 5th.

You may sign up for one or more days per week, and one activity per day. Most activities have limited space and are available on a first come first serve basis. Please keep in mind that your child will be expected to attend the activities for which he or she is registered, unless an absence is documented with the school. If your child is present during the school day but will not attend the After School Program, please call the office and leave word so that we know not to expect him/her.
